4. Difference from the Last Release (ver. 4.06.1035)

- (1) Changed the range of the maximum and minimum values of the volume controls that can be customized by INF file.
- (2) Fixed the problem that a GPF occurred when we move HW volumes in restarting the Windows.
- (3) If the data from SPDIF In has the copyright bit asserted, nothing will can be recorded. (Same behavior as Ver. 200x drivers.)
- (4) Wait time for resuming the PCM Volume can be customized to avoid noise problem.
- (5) Fixed the problem that occurred when we move the HW volume in playing MPEG files.
- (6) A3D module has been updated.
